Grades: 4-8 (Grade levels as of 2019-2020 school year), open to ALL LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICTS

Cost: \$140 per camper (20% 2nd sibling discount = \$112)

Campers will be taught by All-Conference Putnam Valley High seniors and camp directors TJ Brescia & John Millicker (both multi-sport athletes), among others. The recreation department will have several other supervisory employees at the facility for safety purposes.

PVPR Line Drive Baseball program's campers will be grouped by age, ability and physical maturity in an all-for-one and one-for-all mentality in a safe, structured environment with a camp-ending Barbeque on final day.
